A RESOLUTION SETTING A SPECIAL ELECTION FOR MARCH 5, 2019  
FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING A GENERAL OBLIGATION DEBT BALLOT  
PROPOSITION TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE CITY OF SOLDOTNA

WHEREAS, the Soldotna City Council (Council) would like to place the question of issuance of general obligation debt, for the purpose of financing construction of the Soldotna Regional Sports Complex Field House Expansion, to the qualified voters of the City of Soldotna; and

WHEREAS, the Council would like the question to be placed before the voters prior to the next regular election; and

WHEREAS, Soldotna Municipal Code (SMC) 4.04.040(B) provides that the council, by resolution, may call a Special Election at least 75 days prior to the date of the election; and


WHEREAS, the Council desires to set March 5, 2019 as the date for a Special Election;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOLDOTNA, ALASKA:



**SUBJECT:** Resolution 2018-045 - Setting a Special Election for March 5, 2019 for the Purpose of Submitting a General Obligation Debt Ballot Proposition to the Qualified Voters of the City of Soldotna

During the October 8, 2018 City Council Field House Work Session the general discussion made by all participants identified that the Voters of the City of Soldotna should be allowed to determine if the Soldotna Regional Field House project should move forward.

The general discussion also indicated that the bond issuance should be submitted to the voters prior to the next Regular Election. In order to stay in compliance with State Statute, Soldotna Municipal Code and noticing requirements the soonest a Special Election could be held is Monday, February 25, 2019.

It is the recommendation of the City Clerk to schedule the Special Election on March 5, 2019 to allow for additional noticing of a Special Election.
